SCRIPTURE: Matthew 14:22-33

Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, Jesus was there alone, but by this time the boat, battered by the waves, was far from the land, for the wind was against them. And early in the morning he came walking toward the disciples on the sea. But when the disciples saw Jesus walking on the sea, they were terrified, saying, "It is a ghost!"
